#### SAM R. ADKISSON, CLASS OF 1951 2008 DISTINGUISHED ALUMNUS OF THE YEAR



2008 Distinguished Alumnus, Sam Adkisson, '51, receives award from Alumni Association President, Mario Conte, '79.

Each year the Dental Alumni Association names a Distinguished Alumnus and this year Col. Sam R. Adkisson was chosen as the recipient.

Dr. Adkisson received his B.S. degree from Hendrix College in 1947 and his D.D.S. degree from Washington University School of Dentistry in 1951. Dr. Adkisson served in the Dental Corps of

the U.S. Air Force for 27 years. During this period he received his certificate in Prosthodontics from Tufts University in Boston, Mass. He was certified as a Diplomat of the American Board of Prosthodontics. Dr. Adkisson was elected a Fellow of the American College of Dentists. He became a Charter Fellow of the American College of Prosthodontics.

Adkisson received the Air Force Commendation Medal three times. He also received the Meritorious medal. Dr. Adkisson received the Legion of Merit on the occasion of his retirement in 1978.

In the second phase of his professional Adkisson life, Dr. served on the faculty of the University of Texas Dental Branch-Houston, Texas for 29 years. He was promoted to full professor with tenure. He received the premier McGovern Teaching Award four times. Dr. Adkisson received the Alumni Association Award for teaching excellence and was listed on the Dean's Teaching Excellence List 16 times. Dr. Adkisson retired from teaching

on December 31, 2007 but remains active in many study club activities.

Upon his return to Houston, Dr. Adkisson wrote:

"Let me thank you for a delightful visit to St. Louis. Every detail of our visit was just perfect! What delight to see the school as well as some of my classmates -Sam Guyer, Lester Kreader and Neal Newton... The Alumni Award especially honors the entire Class of 1951, a stalwart group of young men who set out to eliminate dental disease! We didn't quite achieve that goal - leaving a bit for the rest of you to solve! Thanks again for your hospitality and kindness during our visit to St. Louis."





#### Alumni Association Continuing Education Program





and Mosby Publishing.


