JAIME A. YRASTORZA, CLASS OF 1957 2012 DISTINGUISHED ALUMNUS OF THE YEAR

Each year the Washington University Dental Alumni Association (WUDAA) selects a Distinguished Alumnus and this year Dr. Jaime A. Yrastorza was chosen as the recipient.

Dr. Yrastorza was born in the Philippines and matriculated to The University of Minnesota, where he received his undergraduate degree. Dr. Yrastorza then came to St. Louis, where he graduated from The Washington University Dental School in 1957 with his DDS degree.

From St. Louis, Dr. Yrastorza took a Rotating Dental Internship at the Providence Hospital, Washington, D.C. Thereafter, he entered a combined graduate studies program at the Schools of Dentistry & Medicine of Georgetown University and its affiliated Oral Surgery Residency Program at Georgetown University Hospital and the D.C. General Hospital. He graduated in 1961 with a Master of Science in Oral Surgery.

The following two years he served as Chief Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery of the Veteran Administration Hospital in Wadsworth, Kansas while participating as a Clinical instructor of the Oral Surgery

residency Program of the University of Kansas City School of Dentistry.

In 1963, Dr. Yrastorza started a private practice in Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery in Wheat Ridge, Colorado, where he remained in practice until his retirement in 1995.

During his long, distinguished career, Dr. Yrastorza successfully advocated for the inclusion of a Department of Dentistry & Oral Surgery at the St. Anthony's Hospital of Denver and Lutheran Medical Center of Wheat Ridge, CO. He served as Chair of both Departments for 15 years. He has spoken before many prestigious Societies & Associations, and was published in many Professional Journals. He served as a Consultant Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeon of the VA Hospital of Denver, the Oral Surgery Residency Program of Denver General Hospital, the St. Anthony's Dental Intern Program and a Clinical Associate Professor in Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery for the School of Dentistry of the University of Colorado.

In 1989, Dr. Yrastorza founded a nonprofit organization, Uplift Internationale. This organization provides help to the children of impoverished

families in rural Philippines who have facial deformities, primarily clefts of the lip and palate. This is life changing care, mending faces...one child at a time. Hundreds of children have benefited from this humanitarian project.

Dr. Yrastorza is a Lifetime Fellow of the International Association of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons and a Fellow of the American College of Dentists. He is a life member of the American Association of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons, the Colorado Society of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons, the Metropolitan Denver Dental Society and the Colorado Dental Association. Dr. Yrastorza is a recipient of the Metropolitan Denver Den-

tal Society Community Service Recognition Award, the Physician Community Service Award of the Lutheran Medical Center and the Lifetime Achievement Award of the National Federation of Filipino American Association. He has also served as President of the Metropolitan Denver Dental Society and the Rocky Mountain Dental Study Club.

Dr. Yrastorza has been married to his wife, Patricia, for 55 years. They have 5 children and fourteen grandchildren. Among their children, they have a Yoga instructor, a Physical Therapist, a Physician's Assistant in Neurosurgery, and a Dermatologist. One of their grandchildren wishes to be an Orthodontist.

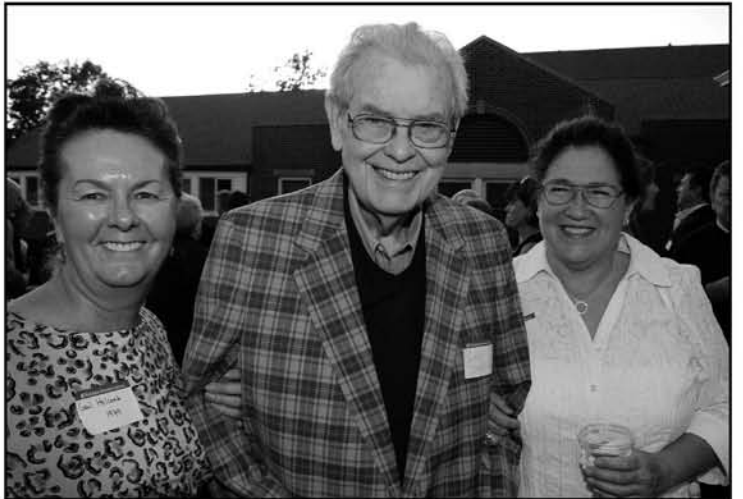

We had over 80 people in attendance for the Saturday morning lectures.

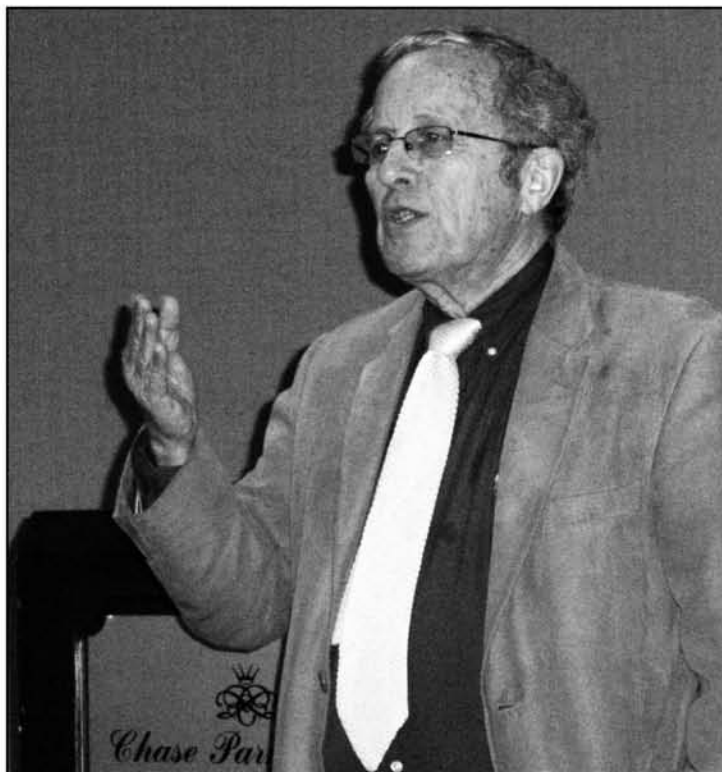

The Washington University Dental Alumni Association Scholarship for the Study of Dental Medicine

The Alumni Association of the Washington University School of Dental Medicine (WUDAA) has created a scholarship for the study of Dental Medicine. Washington University no longer has a School of Dental Medicine; however, the Alumni Association would like to continue its long history of supporting quality dental education. The Alumni Association believes that this scholarship will help a promising student complete his or her dental education, thereby, helping the public receive quality dental care.

Our goals initially are to award one scholarship each year to a deserving dental student who is a direct descendant of a WUDAA member. To grow the Scholarship Fund, we are requesting financial contributions. Fund donations are tax deductible, complying with all IRS requirements to maintain a 501 (c)(3) status. With the growth of the Scholar-

ship Fund, through the generous contributions of our Alumni and like-minded individuals, we would hope to broaden the scope of the awards and possibly explore expanding the applicant base. With a \$50,000 Fund, we had projected the ability to offer an annual scholarship in perpetuity. However, the world financial changes have conspired against that plan. We need your continued support. Contributions can be in the name of anyone you choose, such as a loved one, classmate, professor, etc. Please be sure to designate your desire to do so when you send your donation. Donations will be acknowledged in the Newsletter unless anonymity is requested.

As of early 2013, the balance of the Scholarship Fund is approximately \$53,000. We already have given six scholarships to six promising dental students. Through the generous donations of our Alumni,

family and friends, we achieved our initial goal of \$50,000 in the five years since the inception of the Fund. But we must press onward. Current projections suggest that with a \$75,000 Fund, we will be able to offer an annual scholarship in perpetuity. We are so grateful for the kindness and generosity of all who have contributed to this worthwhile endeavor!

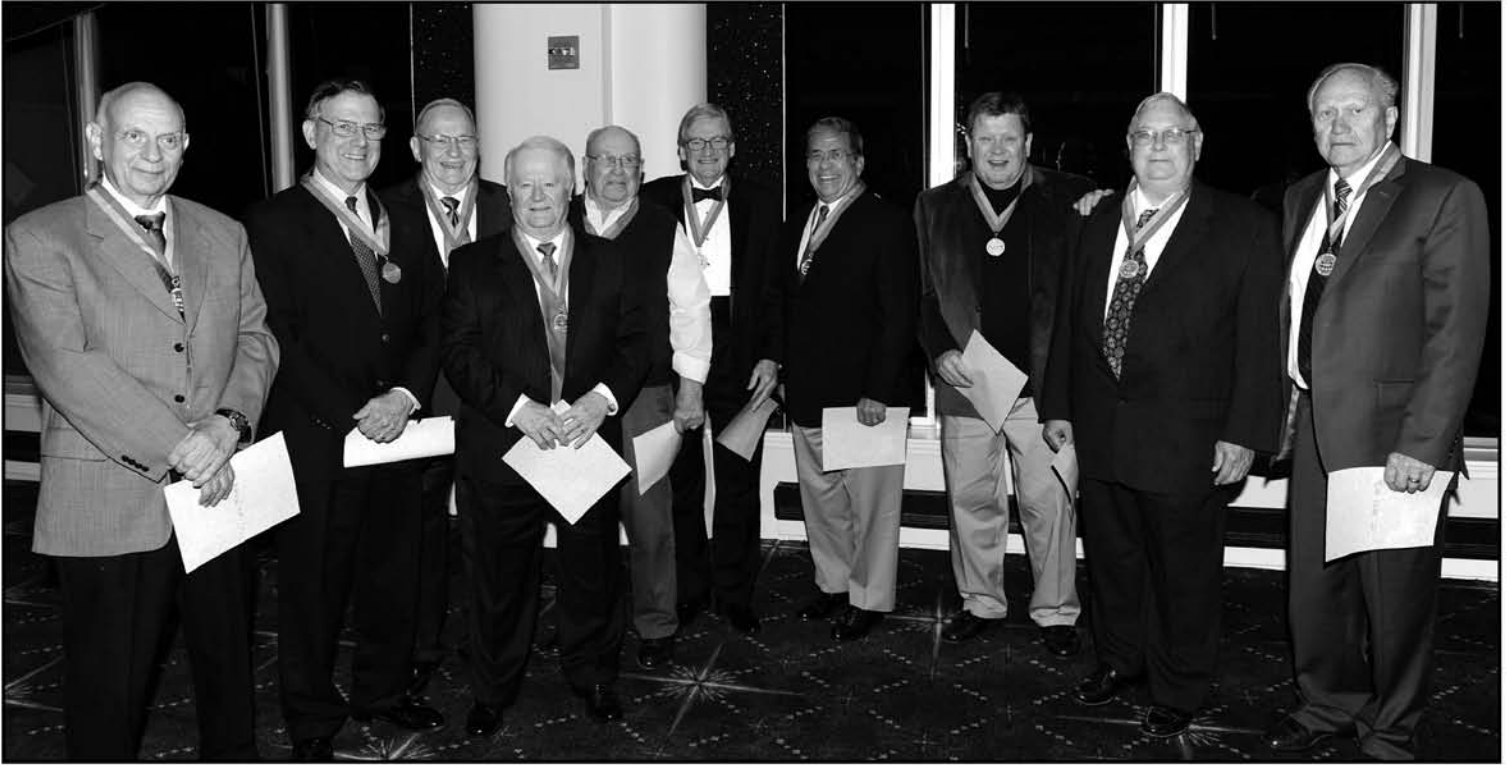

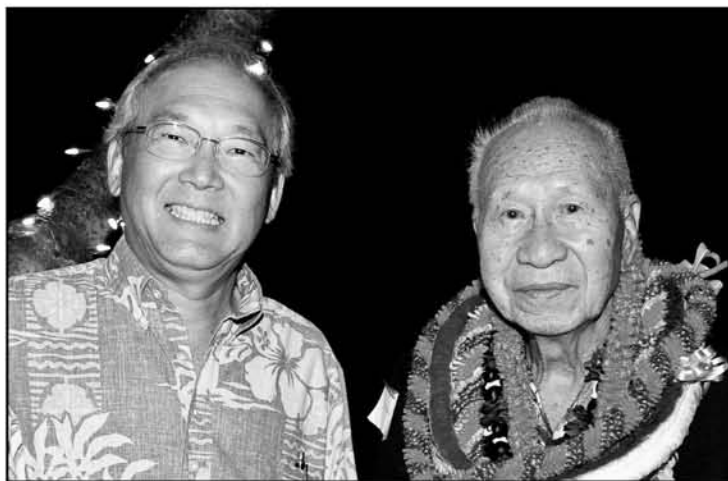

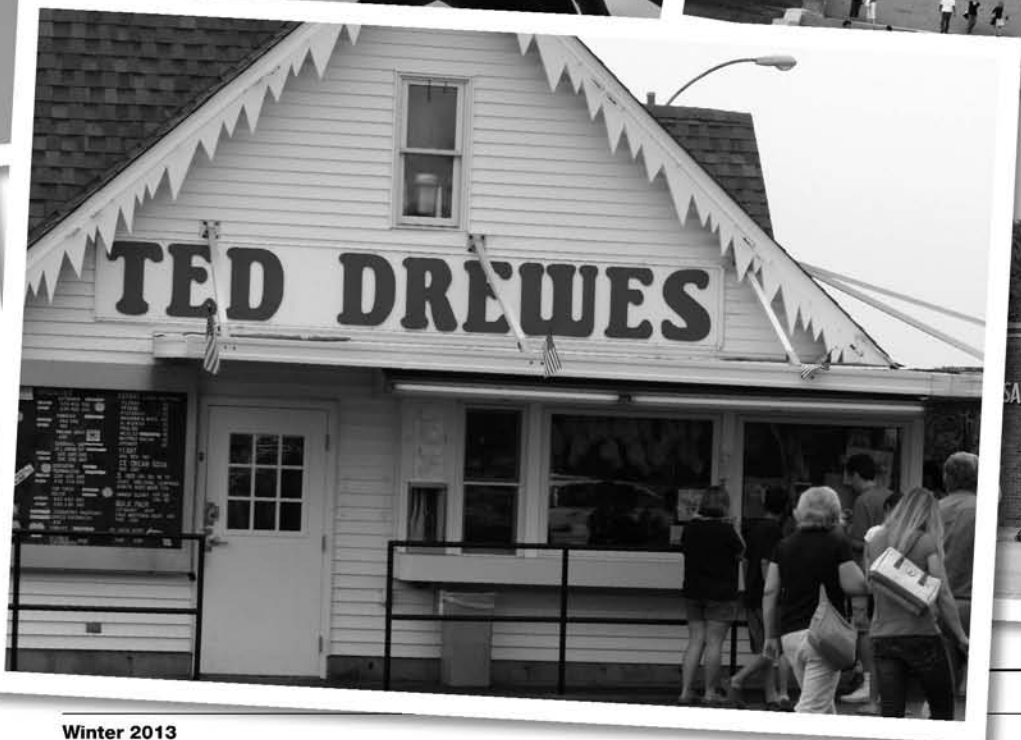
